Organization Description: Eliya Israel, founded in 1982, is the principal organization in Israel providing full-week specialized programs to meet the needs of preschool blind and visually impaired children, and is now considered a leading center of its kind in the world.

Eliya's programs, help enable visually impaired children to assimilate into the general educational system at an early age and become contributing members of society. Eliya has developed a uniquely successful methodology that nurtures and trains newly born children with visual handicaps, utilizing a one-on-one therapy with educators, and specially trained teaching staff.

Eliya is a recognized leader in the innovation of new systems and technologies that are being utilized worldwide.

Fun Fact: Eliya operates at the following three facilities in Israel:

- *Petach Tikva branch - covers the whole central region
- * Be'er Sheva branch - covers the south of the country
- * Jerusalem branch - covers Israel's capital and surrounding area

In 2005 Eliya's Executive Director received the Israel President's Award for Volunteerism (he has been volunteering as an Executive Director for 25 years).

Eliya offers the following programs: Hydrotherapy, Family Holiday, Music Therapy, Rehabilitative Horseback Riding, Art Therapy, Summer Day-Camp for Graduates, Pet Therapy, Shiatsu, Evaluation & Instruction Program, Parent-and-Baby Program.
